BAY & OCEAN PAVILION

What does my ticket include?
 The Aquarium includes the Bay & Ocean Pavilion, the Marsh Pavilion and the scenic Nature Trail connecting the two buildings.

Do you have wheelchairs available?
 Yes. Wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis, free of charge. Please ask at Guest Services.

Can I leave and return?
 Yes. Retain your ticket stub to re-enter either of our two buildings all day.

Is food available at the Aquarium?
 Yes. In the Bay & Ocean Pavilion, you can visit the Aquarium Cafe or IMAX Snack Stop. Or stop by the Otter Snack Bar, just outside the Marsh Pavilion on the Nature Trail.
Food and drinks are not allowed in the exhibit areas or on the Nature Trail.

Can I take pictures in the Aquarium?
 Yes, but please observe any signage prohibiting flash photography, as some of our animals are sensitive to bright light. Any commercial use of still or motion pictures taken at the Aquarium without written consent is prohibited.
