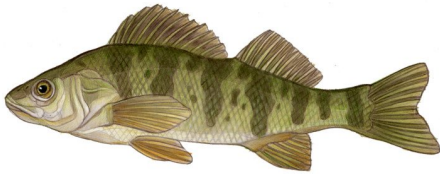


# Color My World

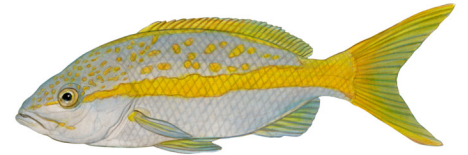
## Yellow Perch

During spawning season, the stripes on the male yellow perch get much darker.



## Yellow Tang

As members of the surgeonfish family, these fish have a retractable blade just before their tails for defense.



## Yellowtail Snapper

Known for its delicious sushi, snapper is commercially fished. When buying snapper, look for sustainable logos!



## Green Sunfish

During nesting season, the male of this species will build and protect the nest.



## Green Tree Frog

Even though this frog is bright green, it blends in perfectly with leaves and grasses.



## Green Sea Turtle

While this turtle isn't green on the outside, its insides are tinted green from all the vegetation it eats.



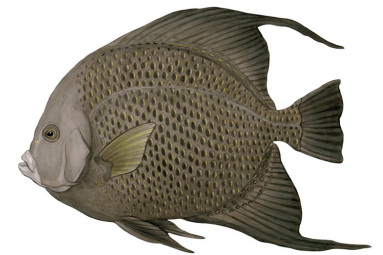
## Bluegill

This animal gets its name from the blue/black spot on its operculum (gill cover).



## Blue Parrotfish

Parrotfish eat algae that grow around dead coral. They poop out the coral as sand.



## Gray Angelfish

This is the largest marine species of angelfish. It can grow to be 60 cm across—bigger than a large pizza!
