Enjoy a winter day exploring how we study weather and climate. Step out on our decks overlooking Owls Creek to take measurements, investigate an ice core to learn about our climate history, and see how animals adapt to daily and long term changes. Activities are hands-on and geared for all ages to explore and have fun!

Weather & Climate Activities

Classroom, 9:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

Use observations and tools to measure the day's weather such as temperature, wind speed and direction, humidity, and cloud cover as well as build and test your own weather instruments. Explore wintery weather through play and designing your own snowflakes. To learn about how scientists study past climates, examine model ice cores and identify events that altered the climate.

Live Animal Encounters

Classroom, 10:30 & 11:30 a.m.

Meet one of our animal ambassadors to learn how they adapt to daily changes in weather and how a changing climate impacts their species.

Weather Demonstrations

Classroom, 11:00 a.m. & 12:00 p.m.

Learn how to recreate weather phenomenon like lightning or a tornado.
