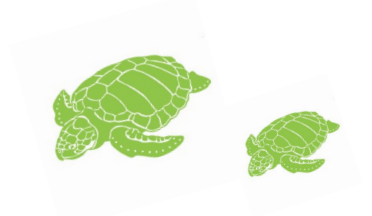


# Virtual Programs

### Toddlers (Ages 2 - 3)

#### Tiny Tot Sea Turtles

Observe sea identifying sea turtle body parts and behavior with a song and letter of the day.

#### Tiny Tot Sharks

Join us for the letter of the day and a song while exploring our Norfolk Canyon Exhibit and identifying shark body parts and behavior.

### Preschool & Kindergarten (Ages 4 - 6)

#### Turtle Tales

Explore sea turtles and identify how they move, get their food, protect themselves, and grow.

#### Shark Senses

Observe our shark exhibit and identify shark senses.

### School-Aged (Grades 1 - 12)

#### Sea Turtle Survivor (1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>)

Explore our Light Tower Exhibit and identify the life stages of a sea turtle and what it takes to survive in the open ocean.

#### Shark Survivor (1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>)

Observe our Norfolk Canyon Exhibit and identify the role sharks and rays play in the ecosystem.

#### Fishes of the Chesapeake Bay (2<sup>nd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>)

Dive into our Chesapeake Bay Aquarium to observe fish shapes and behavior. Learn how this dynamic ecosystem supports a variety of biodiversity.

#### Ocean Zones (Grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>)

Learn about the zones of life in the ocean, and the amazing adaptations of animals for surviving in the deep, dark sea.

**Science SOLs: 3.4, 3.5, 3.6, 3.10, 4.5, and 4.9**

## School-Aged (Grades K - 12)

### Animal Encounters: Life Cycles (K-2<sup>nd</sup>)

Act out the life cycles of a butterfly and frog, match animals and their eggs, and learn about how animals change as they grow.

### Animal Encounters: Compare Animal Groups (2<sup>nd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>)

Explore the five classes of vertebrate animals – Fish, Birds, Mammals, Reptiles, and Amphibians by examining real biofacts and observing animals.

**Science SOLs: 2.5, 3.6, 4.5, 5.6, 6.7**

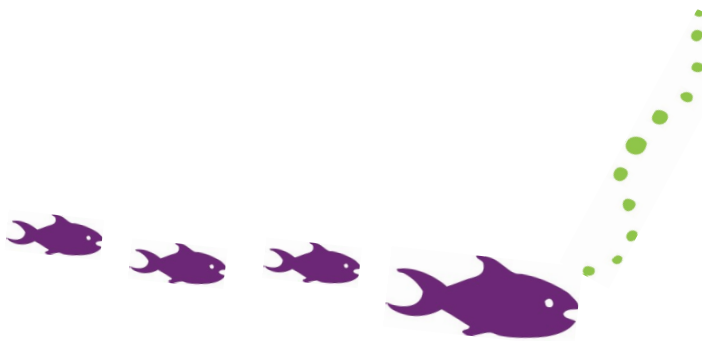
### Animal Encounters: Habitats & Adaptations (3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>)
